

BHORA AGM 20 April 2018: Minutes

1. Meeting opened at 7.35pm with Chairman's welcome and thanks to Committee Members for their work during past year.
2. Chairman's Report by Stephen Dalziel.
3. Treasurer's report by Caroline Chenier.
4. Election of Committee: The current Committee was re-elected, and Jenny Edwards and Helen Kakouris were elected as new members to join the Committee.
5. Presentation by local MP, Bambos Charalambous. He gave a summary of local issues as he sees them and illustrated his case load as an MP, citing a few examples.
6. Presentation by Karl Brown on the London plans and how these may affect the local area, notably for housing, traffic and cycling.
