- ♦ What's being done and what else could be done to improve air quality for you and our children

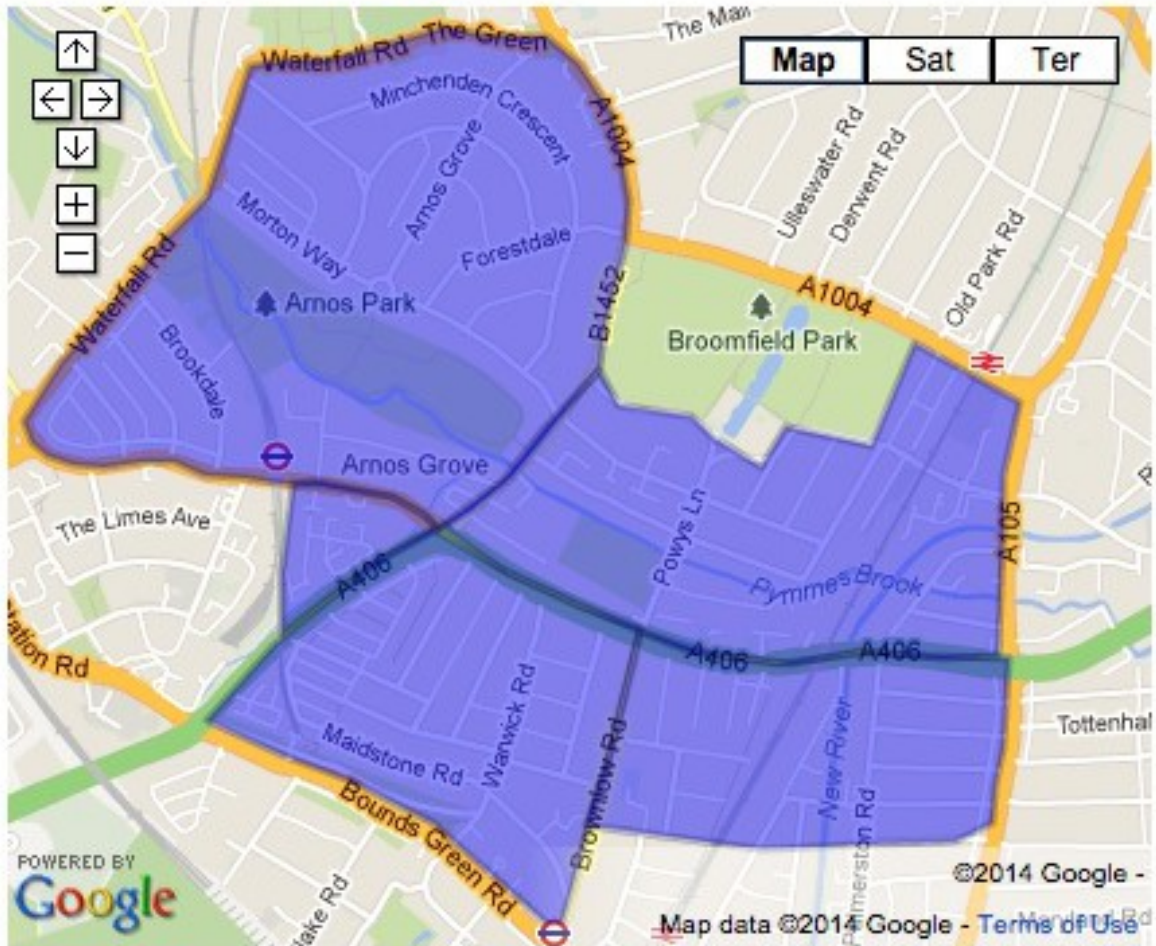
